

A COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS OF WORKING CAPITAL MANAGEMENT OF COAL INDIA LTD. AND GUJARAT MINERAL DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION LTD

Working capital management plays a significant role in keeping the wheels of firm running. The intention of this study is to compare and analyze the efficiency of working capital management of selected units. To achieve the objectives two coal industries listed in Bombay stock exchange are selected for the study. Secondary data collected from the period 2011 - 2016 from annual published reports and investment sites. Various financial ratios and statistical tool as spearman correlation coefficient and "t test" used in the present study to determine the relationship between liquidity and profitability. The study disclosed that liquidity and profitability position of Coal India Ltd. is better than Gujarat Mineral Development Corporation Ltd.

Impact of merger and acquisitions on financial performance: Evidence from selected companies in India

This research paper scrutinized the impact of merger and acquisitions on the financial performance of selected acquirer firms across India. The particular paper seeks objec -tives of effect of merger upon profitability and liquidity position. It analyzes three years pre and post-merger financial performance of the companies. Sample size of this research consists of selected seven different industries undergone merger and acquisitions during 2006 - 2012. To achieve the study's objective secondary data of three years prior and post-merger collected from annual audited financial statements from period 2000- 2015. Various financial ratios applied to assess the profitability & liquidity position. The analysis is conducted with the help of statistical tool paired t test used on accounting ratios by SPSS to test the significance of the study.



The finding of this study shows that there is no improvement in financial performance of acquirer companies after merger. Post -merger profitability and liquidity indicators of selected sample deteriorated.

Using these tools, the real time tweets and messages can be extracted from Twitter, Facebook, WhatAapp and many other social medial portals. In this article, the implementation of fetch ing live tweets from Twitter using python programming is presented. By this approach, the emotional attributes of the Internet users on social medial portals can be analyzed and prediction is done. Suppose we want to evaluate the overall cumulative score of a celebrity. For this, the python or PHP based programming scripts can fetch the live tweets about that celebrity or renowned person from Twitter. After that, using natural language processing toolkits, the fetched data in form of tweets or messages can be analyzed and prediction is done whether that particular person or movie or celebrity is getting fame or not.

ERP Implementation – Some critical factors

Abstract

Implementing an ERP causes massive change that needs to be carefully managed to reap the benefits of an ERP solution. Critical issue that must be carefully considered to ensure successful implement ation include commitment from top management, reengineering of the existing processes, integration of the ERP with other business of information system, selection and management of consultants and employees, and training of employees on the new system. The IT literature has clearly demonstrated that for IT projects to succeed top management support is critical. This also applies to ERP implementations. Implementing an ERP system is not matter of changing software systems, rather it is a matter of repositioning the company and transforming the business practices. Due to enormous impact on the competitive advantage of the company, top management must consider the strategic implications of implementing an ERP solution. Management must ask several questions before embarking on the project. Does the ERP system strengthen the company's competitive position? How might it erode the company's competitive position? How does ERP affect the organizational

structure and the culture? What is scope of the ERP implementation - only a few functional units or the entire organization? Are they any alternatives that meet the company's needs better than ERP system? If it is a multinational corporation, the management should be concerned about whether it would be better to roll the system out globally or restrict it to certain regional units? Management must be involved in every step of the ERP implementation. Some companies make the grave mistake of handing over the responsibility of ERP implementation to the technology department. This would risk the entire company's survival because of the ERP system's profound business implications. It is often said that ERP implementation is about people, not processes or technology. An organization goes though a major transformation, and the management of this change must be carefully planned (from a strategic viewpoint) and meticulously implemented. Many parts of the business that used to work in silos now have to be tightly integrated for ERP to work effectively. Cutting corners in planning and implementation is detrimental to a company. The top management must not only fund the project but also take an active role in leading the change. A review of successful ERP implementations has shown that the key to a smooth rollout is effective change management from top. Intervention from management is often necessary to resolve conflicts and bring everybody to the same thinking, and to build cooperation among the diverse groups in the organization, often times across the national borders. Top management need to consultancy monitor the progress of the project and provide direction to the implementation teams. The success of a major project like an ERP implementation completely hinges on the strong, sustained commitment of top management. This commitment when percolated down through the organizational levels results in an overall organization commitment. An overall organizational commitment that is very visible, well defined, and felt is a sure way to ensure a successful implementation.


